COMMUNIQUÉ

Motor Vehicle Dealer's Licence

Holders of Motor Vehicle Dealer's Licence are hereby informed that the licence shall only authorize the use of a motor vehicle between **sunrise and sunset** for proceeding to or from:

- (i) a public weighbridge to ascertain the unladen weight of the vehicle.
- (ii) a place where the vehicle may be registered or inspected by an officer of the Authority.
- (iii) the premises of the licensee from or to a post of embarkation or airport.
- (iv) the premises of another licensee.
- (v) the place of a potential purchaser of the vehicle.
- (vi) a place where a test or trial is made, repair/painting of the vehicle/garage, showroom or has been stored/exposed.
- (vii) for towing purposes.

Moreover, the vehicle shall carry-

- (a) no load, other than the ballast required for testing.
- (b) on a public holiday, no person other than the driver of the vehicle.
- (c) on any other day, other than a public holiday, not more than 3 persons at a time from one of the following groups of persons-
the licensee, his employees and potential purchaser of the vehicle.
- (d) Securely fixed **in front and to the rear** in a conspicuous position, **an identification plate as approved by the Authority.**

Any person who uses a motor vehicle in breach of the regulation shall commit an offence. Licensees are, therefore, strongly advised to abide to the above regulation.
