### STUDENT IDENTITY CARD IN RESPECT OF FREE TRAVEL

The National Transport Authority (NTA) informs the public that **only a Student Identity Card is valid for free travel of a student** from his/her residence to his/her school/institution and back, during school days.

A Student Identity Card is issued by only the NTA and **no other documents** authorise a student to benefit from the Free Travel Scheme.

The attention of schools, institutions and bus operators are accordingly drawn to the above.

The fees for Student identity Card are as follows:

New/Renewal	Rs 100
Changes (address/name)	Rs 100
Loss (Issue of Duplicate)	Rs 300
